NTPC - A superpower for India

- ▶ Installed capacity of 32,194 MW through 27 power stations.
- ▶ Operates 15 coal based, 7 gas based and 5 joint venture power stations.
- ▶ Contributes 28.36% of country's power with PLF of 90.81%.
- ▶ Aims to become 75,000 MW plus company by year 2017 & 1,28,000 MW plus company by year 2032.

Dadri Project - Surpassing standards

- ▶ Country's Only 3-in-1 project - coal based, gas based and convertor based stations.
- ▶ 980 MW (2x490 MW) Stage-II will benefit Delhi and Uttar Pradesh. Power from 840 MW coal based station (Stage-I) is being supplied to Delhi and Uttar Pradesh. Power from 817 MW gas based station is supplied to UP, Uttarakhand, J&K, HP, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Punjab, Delhi and Indian Railways.
