

India hits back at new Pak map: among IS group which stormed Afghan iail **'An exercise in political absurdity'** "We have seen a so-called princely state of Junagadh

We have seen a so-called political map of Pakistan that has been released by Prime Minister Imran Khan. This is an exercise in political absurdity, laying un-tenable claims to territories in the Indian State of Gujarat and our Union Territories of Jammu & Kabewin and of Loduk There & Kashmir and of Ladakh. In fact, this new effort only confirms the reality of Pakistan's obsession with ter-ritorial aggrandisement sup-ported by cross-border terror-ism, "the MEA said in an official statement. The map was un-

veiled by Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan, who claimed that it negates India's'il-legal action' of August 5, and that it had been endorsed by the federal cabinet. This map will now be officially used in Pakistan's curriculum, Khan said. The map devicts the entirety

The Pakistan cabinet also ap-proved the decision to rename a major road in Islamabad as Srinagar Highway. The road was previously called Kashmir Highway. This is not the first time Pakistan has tried to portray Junagach as part of its territory. The 2012 Atlas of Islamic Republic of Pakistan also por-trayed Junagach as a separate
